### THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- 1. the retainer agreement entered into with the proposed representative plaintiff Sara Ramsay is approved;
- 2. legal fees in the amount of \$725,000.00 plus applicable taxes with respect to the settlement agreement entered into with the defendants TOKIN Corporation and TOKIN America Inc., formerly known as NEC TOKIN Corporation and NEC TOKIN America Inc. dated May 30, 2018 (the "Settlement Agreement") are approved for BC, Ontario and Quebec Class Counsel (collectively, "Class Counsel");
- 3. payment of \$225,000.00 plus applicable taxes, is applied as a partial reimbursement against the total disbursements collectively incurred by Class Counsel;
- 4. Class Counsel legal fees, applicable taxes, disbursement and applicable taxes shall be paid from the settlement funds, payable pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement;
- 5. this Order is contingent upon parallel orders being made by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice and the Quebec Superior Court, and the terms of this Order shall not be effective unless and until such orders are made by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice and the Quebec Superior Court.
- 6. endorsement of this Order by counsel for the Defendants shall be dispensed with.
